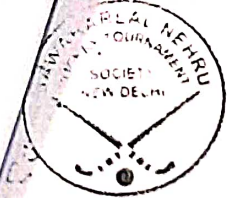

The Jawaharlal Nehru Hockey Tournament Society, since inception in 1964, has been deeply engaged in the promotion of national game of Hockey especially at the grass root level in country. We propose to hold the following tournaments at Shri Stadium, New Delhi as per the programme given below :-

- i) 50th Nehru Junior Hockey Tournament
(Boys Under 17 years) -- Sept 02-13, 2022
- ii) 39th Nehru Sub-Junior
Hockey Tournament
(Boys Under 15 years) -- Sept 15-26, 2022
- iii) 28th Nehru Girls Hockey
Tournament (Under 17 years) -- Sept 28 to Oct 9, 2022

These tournaments backed by handsome prize money award of approximately Rs. 2.99 lacs each are now the pre-eminence competitions at the school level in the country. It is gratifying to mention that the response from the State Government in sponsoring teams to these tournaments after holding qualified competitions at the District and State levels through their Director of Education/Sports has been very encouraging. This has not only widened the base of Hockey in the country but has also given practical shape to the often repeated slogan "CATCH THEM YOUNG".

As the tournaments are confined to the school teams with maximum age of participants viz. 15 years or 17 years, as the case may be, has to be adhered to strictly. The age will be determined on 1st November, 2022. Further details about the tournament and also the conditions applicable for age limit are enclosed (Annexure-I & II).

CONDITION OF PARTICIPATING & INSTRUCTIONS FOR AGE LIMIT IN THE JUNIOR GIRLS, THE JUNIOR (BOYS) AND SUB-JUNIOR (BOYS) TOURNAMENTS.

Being the age group tournaments, the Society shall strictly adhere to the age restriction of 15 years & 17 years, as the case may be as on *1st November, 2022*. The participating school should therefore, ensure that no student above the prescribed age limit is included in the team.

Before playing their first match, it is obligatory for each participating team to submit a list of its sixteen players who will be representing the institution in the tournament. Names of players once intimated cannot be changed without prior approval of the Tournament Director. The particulars of the players will be verified by the office before the players are screened by a Medical Committee and those found above the prescribed age limit will be disqualified for participation in the tournament and their names deleted from the list of sixteen players already submitted to the Tournament Director.

The criteria adopted by the Committee for determining the age is enclosed. To avoid any embarrassment, therefore, the schools concerned are well advised to have the preliminary screening done of their own to ensure that all the players included in the team are within the prescribed age limit. The tendency on the part of some of the teams to field overage players has to be curbed at all cost and in this direction we seek your cooperation in the larger interest of the game.

2. According to the Rules of the Tournament, the players should have been on the rolls of the school for at least two month prior to *1st November, 2022*. All members of the team taking part in the tournament are required to bring their *BIO-DATA* attested by the Principal/Head of the Institutions under his/her signature and seal, and *Identity Cards* issued by the School/Institution. Original Aadhar Card, Passport, Birth Certificate issued by the local body, Voter ID Card, 10th Grade Mark Sheet and Hockey India ID Card if available.

3. The Society has also introduced "*Prize Money*" of the value of (Approx) *Rs.2.99 lacs* as an incentive to young players for achieving excellence in the game. The prize money to the winning teams is intended for 16 players.

4. In view of the heavy expenditure involved in holding these tournaments and the limited resources of the Society, we seek the co-operation of the State Governments, as in the past, to bear travel expenses of the team. During its stay the Society will, of course, make suitable boarding and lodging arrangements for the teams and also ensure that healthy nutritious food is served to the participants. The subsidized charges for providing boarding, lodging and local transport etc., will be Rs.400/- per head per day.

5. The confirmation letter from Principal/President/Director of the participating team should reach to JNHT Society latest by 10th August, 2022 for Junior (Boys u-17 years), Sub-Junior (Boys u-15 years) Hockey Tournaments and Junior Girls (u-17 years) Hockey Tournament on 20th August 2022.

RAPID ASSESSMENT - 15 YEARS TO 17 YEARS BY PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

The introduction of Sub-Junior and Junior competitions in sports necessitates the establishment of age of the participants by certified date of birth. At time various teams have over aged players causing resentment and protest by opponent teams. It is, therefore, become necessary to conduct a medical examination of players suspected to be over aged.

The medical examination for assessment of age requires physical examination and dental investigation. As facilities of detailed investigation do not exist everywhere, the following criteria are mentioned below for rapid assessment of age of the player at 15 to 17 years.

The criteria generally applies to boys. In the case of Girls, the age determination is by Dental age as mentioned at SL.No. 3 & 4 below and the general appearance.

TABLE SHOWING PHYSICAL CRITERIA FOR ASSESSMENT
OF AGE OF BOYS AT 15 AND 17 YEARS.

PHYSICAL CRITERIA	15 YEARS	17 YEARS
1. Height	164 to 174 CM	164 to 180
2. Weight	50.5 to 60 KG	60 to 74 KG
3. No. of teeth	28	28
4. Eruption of 3 rd Molar teeth	17 years to 22 years	
5. Axillary hair growth	Hair starts appearing in armpit at 15 to 16 years of age	
6. Facial hair	Facial hair starts appearing at 15 to 16 years of age	
7. Moustaches and beard	Hair starts appearing at corner of the upper lip and spreads over the upper part of the cheek and lastly the lower border of middle of the chin.	
8. Size of the Areola of male breast	Before adolescence it is 12.5 mm in diameter. After 17 to 18 years it is about 21.5 mm diameter.	
9.	All the above criteria are taken together for the assessment of age. Sometimes even detailed physical examination it becomes difficult to determine the age of the player. In such case the players are advised to get the X-Rays of the bones taken to assess their correct age.
